June 24, 2010 - Full Day Every Day Kindergarten added to Caroline Robins Community School

Today, the Board of Education for Saskatoon Public Schools announced that the Full Day, Every Day, Literacy Enhanced Kindergarten program option will be added to Caroline Robins Community School in the fall. The addition of this program will provide enhanced learning opportunities to the youngest learners in the Westview community.

Through this addition of this Full Day, Every Day, Literacy Enhanced Kindergarten program, the Saskatoon Board of Education continues to demonstrate its commitment to student learning along with its growing leadership in the area of Early Learning and Literacy.

A key component of *Literacy for Life*, Saskatoon Public Schools was the first division in the city to offer literacy-enhanced Full Day Every Day Kindergarten which began in five public schools in September 2005. The following thirteen schools will offer the program in the 2010/2011 school year - Alvin Buckwold, Caroline Robins, Confederation Park, Forest Grove, Holliston, Howard Coad, King George, Lawson Heights, Mayfair, Pleasant Hill, Princess Alexandra, Queen Elizabeth and Vincent Massey Schools. In addition to the offering of Full Day Kindergarten in these schools, a number of public elementary schools offer a Full Day, Alternate Day, Literacy Enhanced Kindergarten program option.
