The My Privacy & Me video competition is sponsored by the Office of the Federal Privacy Commissioner and is a way to encourage teenagers to consider the privacy issues they face every day. Categories for the competition include Targeted Advertising, Surveillance, Online Scams, and Online Reputation.

Media School is a chance for Grade 11 students to spend a semester concentrating on media production. The class takes a film and television centered approach to English 20 and 30B, Physics 20 and Communications Production Technology 20 and 30.

Students receive industry certification in set safety and protocol from Crew Call and develop demo DVDs that they can use to apply to post-secondary film and video courses.
