The Board of Education for Saskatoon Public Schools has refreshed its strategic learning priorities and is pleased to announce the continuation of two significant learning priorities over the next three school years:

- **Collegiate Renewal**

All collegiate students will be engaged in their learning so they will graduate as active participants in life-long learning and as responsible and caring citizens in the community, nation, and world.

- **Literacy for Life**

Saskatoon Public Schools is committed to the goal of all students, K - 8, reading and writing at or above grade level in multiple subject areas so they can act upon their potential in school and in life – ultimately creating a healthier democratic society for the 21st century.

Trustees have spent the past several months discussing the Division's learning priorities. They have consulted with a number of community stakeholders, solicited feedback through public and staff surveys, and consulted with parents and school community councils.
