Transportation

- All United BlueLine taxi transportation is cancelled, except for wheelchair taxis which are running. For more information parents can call United BlueLine directly at 652-2222 or call their child's school to confirm that taxi transportation (except wheelchair) is cancelled.
- Kindergarten busing at lunch is cancelled.
- Students attending the LD programs at Westmount School and John Lake School remain at their home school for the day.
