



FirstStudent busing and taxi transportation resumes for Thursday, January 28, 2010

FirstStudent busing has resumed for Public and Catholic schools in Saskatoon. FirstStudent advises that if a route is modified due to road conditions, parents of student who are impacted will be contacted directly by FirstStudent to make alternate bus stop arrangements. Otherwise parents should have their child go to the regular bus stop at the regular time. We thank parents for their patience and cooperation as service returns.

- **Students being bused to school**

We remind parents that they are responsible for children until they are on the school bus on the way to school. Families should have an alternate plan in place in the event the school bus does not arrive at the scheduled time.

We remind parents of the FirstStudent busing protocol which states, if the bus is late, the student waits 10 minutes and then returns home. Parents should call the FirstStudent bus information line at 343-3300 or FirstStudent at 343-2125 for more information. Unless other directions are provided by FirstStudent, the student returns to the bus pick up location one hour after the original pick up time. (Example: original pick up time is 8:15 a.m. / adjusted pick up time is 9:15 a.m.)

- **Students being bused home**

We remind parents that they are responsible to ensure there is appropriate supervision after FirstStudent drops off their child at his/her regular bus drop off location. We recommend that parents of Kindergarten to Grade Two students meet the bus each day. Parents must have appropriate supervision plans in place once the child is dropped off by the bus.

All taxi service, United BlueLine and taxi shuttle cab wheelchair (Radio), has resumed.
