## FROM THE BOARD TABLE

### Indigenous learning events highlighted for Board of Education

Events and learning experiences in recognition and celebration of Indigenous Peoples History Month were highlighted during the Saskatoon Board of Education meeting June 21.

The celebrations that have taken place during the month of June include Reclaiming Heritage Pre-Contact Wanuskewin Project involving Chief Whitecap and wāhkôhtowin schools, Kishkaytaytaahk Métis Day of Learning at Westmount School, Sylvia Fedoruk School SCC's Indigenous Ensemble performance, and the division-wide Indigenous Peoples History Month Pow Wow and Dance Celebration.

Craig McCallum, a teacher from Mount Royal Collegiate and the school division's Fire Keeper for the 2022-23 school year, spoke with trustees along with Ensemble Mentor Courtney Anaquod, and students from various schools.


The work of schools and division-wide efforts are a direct response to the TRC Calls to Action in which Saskatoon Public Schools honours Indigenous identity to grow collective understanding about identity, histories, and worldview.

The final board meeting of the 2021-22 school year provided Board Chair Colleen MacPherson with the opportunity to reflect on several key areas including: a two-year extension to the division's strategic plan due to interruptions caused by the pandemic; the division's ability to maintain safe and healthy learning and working environments during the pandemic; continuation of planning and next steps for the City Centre Project; an enrolment increase of 500 students; and the support to students and communities provided by Saskatoon Public Schools Foundation.

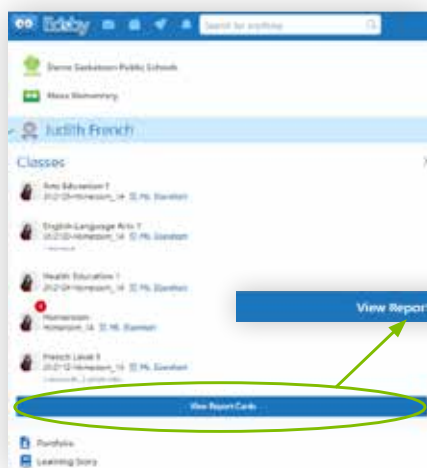
