

AP 316 – MEDICAL CERTIFICATES: STUDENTS

BACKGROUND

Saskatoon Public Schools requires medical certificates to be provided in accordance with these procedures.

PROCEDURES

- Principals shall inform parents or guardians that medical information or certificates shall be submitted to the school for students who have a health condition which may affect the student's work or conduct, or for proof of disability which may necessitate a limiting of the Student's involvement in the school's program or activities. Further, the Principal may request a medical certificate certifying a student's medical fitness, disability or illness.
- 2. Principals shall require certificates from Public Health Services Saskatoon District Health or the child's medical doctor confirming that the child may return to school following communicable diseases regulated by Public Health Services Saskatoon District Health.
