Outbreak declared at wâhkôhtowin School

The Saskatchewan Health Authority (SHA) has declared an outbreak at wâhkôhtowin School.

The SHA notified the school division about the outbreak declaration this afternoon. Communication about the outbreak has been shared with students, staff, and the school community.

Since school started September 1, the SHA has confirmed 10 cases of COVID-19 connected to wahkohtowin School. Classes are continuing as scheduled.

Since the start of the school year, Saskatoon Public Schools has had 123 positive cases at 42 schools in the division.

The safety of our students and staff members is our priority. The safety protocols our schools have in place including mandatory masking and enhanced cleaning are critical to reducing the risk of transmission. Saskatoon Public Schools encourages all eligible students, staff members and parents/caregivers to get the COVID-19 vaccine to help protect the health and well-being of all members of our school communities.

Saskatoon Public Schools is the largest school division in the province. We operate 49 elementary schools, 10 secondary schools, one associate school and one alliance school.
