Historic flag raising at Saskatoon Board of Education

The Treaty 6, Whitecap Dakota First Nation and Métis flags will soon fly above the board office for Saskatoon Public Schools.

The school division will host an event Tuesday to mark the historic flag raising. Tribal Chief Mark Arcand from the Saskatoon Tribal Council, Chief Darcy Bear from Whitecap Dakota First Nation and Glen McCallum from Métis Nation – Saskatchewan are expected to speak at the event, along with Board of Education Vice-Chair Kathleen Brannen.

At the event, the Saskatoon Public Schools Foundation will also announce a significant donation from the Wanuskewin Gift Shop that was fundraised through the sale of Every Child Matters orange t-shirts, designed by Awasis Boutique.
