Outbreak declared at Sylvia Fedoruk School

The Saskatchewan Health Authority (SHA) has declared a COVID-19 outbreak at Sylvia Fedoruk School.

The SHA notified the school division about the outbreak declaration today. Communication about the outbreak has been shared with students, staff, and families at the school.

Since school started September 1, the SHA has confirmed 26 cases of COVID-19 connected to Sylvia Fedoruk School. However, only three of these cases have been confirmed in December. Classes are continuing as scheduled at the school.

This school year, Saskatoon Public Schools has been notified of 327 positive cases at 56 schools in the division.

The safety of our students and staff members is our priority. The safety protocols our schools have in place including mandatory masking and enhanced cleaning are critical to reducing the risk of transmission. Saskatoon Public Schools encourages all eligible students, staff members and parents/caregivers to get the COVID-19 vaccine to help protect the health and well-being of all members of our school communities.

Saskatoon Public Schools is the largest school division in the province. We operate 49 elementary schools, 10 secondary schools, one associate school and one alliance school.
