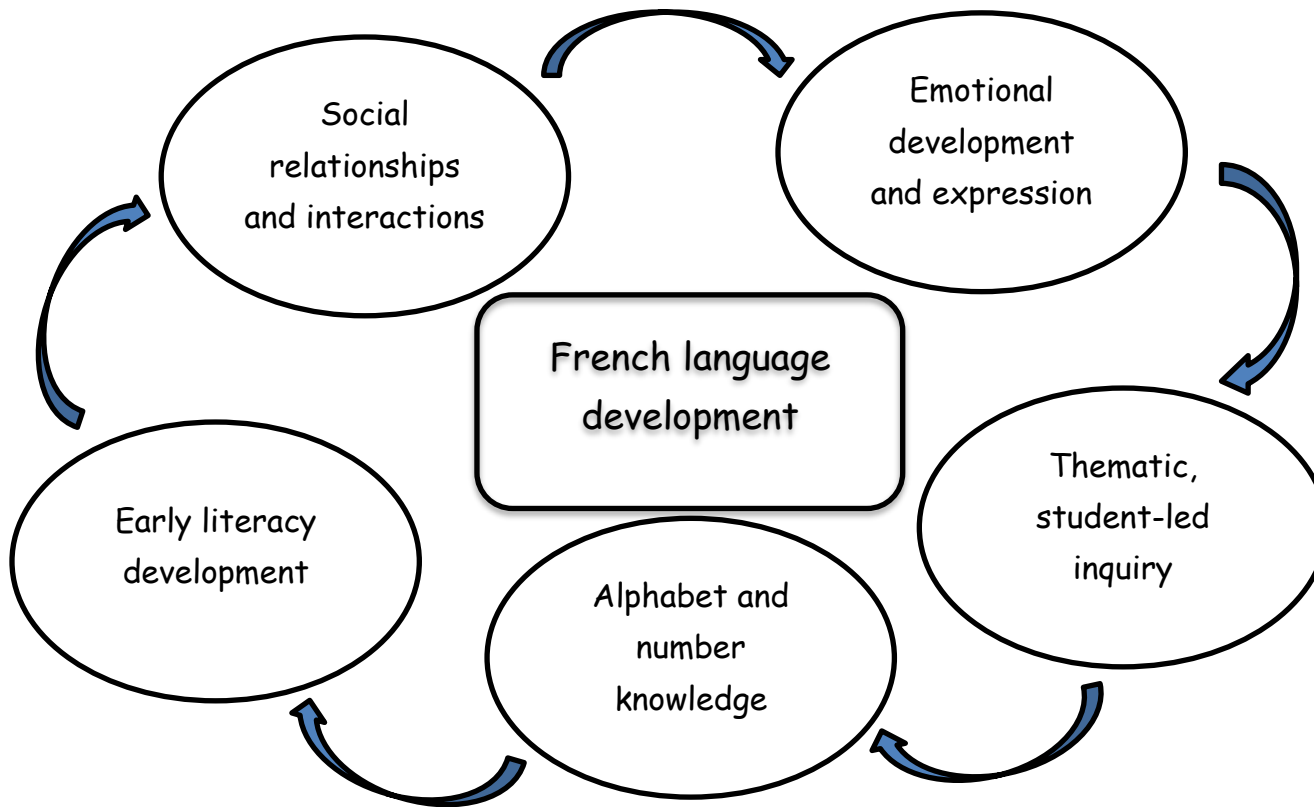


French Immersion: An Interdisciplinary Curriculum

An interdisciplinary curriculum is a means of providing natural connections for student social, personal, and academic learning and development. It begins with French language development, with an emphasis on oral language development, as the foundation for all learning. Children need to be able to negotiate and communicate their understanding in all disciplines with teachers, students, and others. Through authentic contexts and meaningful learning tasks, students develop and use knowledge and skills and ways of being to interact with the world around them.

Contexts may include, but are not limited to the following:
